# 1. INTRODUCTION, ROLL CALL, CALL TO ORDER

At 7:01 p.m., T. Gabrielski called the meeting to order, took roll call, and disclosed the video recording.

## 2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MARCH 13, 2024

3. OLD BUSINESS/ STATUS UPDATE REPORT - R. WILSON

## PARISH RD. - VEHICLE SPEED/SIGNAGE ISSUE

• DPW Highway installed "S Curve" Warning signs on 4/9/24.

#### WEST ST. AND HILLSIDE AVE.

• "Do Not Stop on Tracks" Sign Regulation has been prepared for the 3/12/24 Select Board meeting

#### WEBSTER ST. AT MARK LEE RD. - NEW CROSSWALK

- Conduct a Survey investigation while contractor performs ADA compliance down the road
- Add a crossing to adjacent ramp on far side in addition to existing ramp (less time in roadway)
  - o Crossing to contain block with high visibility, continental lines
- Add flashing crosswalk signage since it is close to the intersection

# CHESTNUT ST. AT EMERSON RD. - POTENTIAL CROSSWALK

The advance sign for the new crossing location may block sight of the bus stop sign

## KIMBALL ST. AND WARREN AVE.

- B. Antonio requests to place permanent speed radar signs on Warren St. section south of Kimble St.
- DPW and T. Gabrielski evaluated for potential solar powered apparatus at locations:
  - o Side lot of the corner of Kimball St. and Warren Ave.
- No line striping, no speed bumps

Members discussed possibility of making a ramp across Warren and Kimball with bump outs.

- Petitioner requested bump outs
- Signage placement would change with bump outs
- It is possible to begin with stanchions at the corner initially?

# CHESTNUT ST. LOCATION OF CROSSWALKS AT WEBSTER ST. AND MARK LEE RD. AND CHESTNUT ST. AT EMERSON RD.

• DPW Engineering investigated mid-block crosswalks on Greendale Ave., Chestnut St. and Webster St. as well as installing "Pedestrian Crossing" warning signs on Chestnut St. near Emerson Rd.

o Per the new MUTCD, <u>Manual On Uniform Traffic Control Devices</u>, the Town may place the signs at this location.

# SPEEDING ON HIGH ROCK, CROSSINGS AT WEBSTER ST./MARK LEE RD. AND CHESTNUT ST./EMERSON RD.

#### FALCON ST. AND BOND ST. - POTENTIAL CROSSWALKS

• Potential crosswalk, continental style, on the north side with appropriate signage

## WASHINGTON ST. AND BANCROFT ST. - POTENTIAL CROSSWALKS

- Crosswalk on left side/west side of Bancroft St. (school roof side) across from Washington St. with appropriate signage
- Stick with the walking route, cross at the beginning

#### HIGH ROCK ST.

- Moved portable speed radar signs from High Rock St. to Brookline St.
  - o Residents request DPW observe drivers speeding down the hill from the school
- Speed data collected will soon be reported
- After an observation period, signs will be redeployed to the Peacedale neighborhood
  - o January petitioner complained that drivers cut through the neighborhood.

#### WEBSTER ST. PROJECT PRESENTED IN JANUARY

- J. McCullen and T. Gabrielski attended a neighborhood meeting.
- Recommendations were to collect baseline data prior to implementing traffic calming changes.
- Other speed radar equipment will be deployed to track speed data along the corridor.

### CORNER OF ROSEMARY ST. AND WEBSTER ST. - BUMP OUT

- Residents do not want a crosswalk with flashing sign near their home
- The Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) is a necessary part of this plan.
- DPW is not comfortable just taking the sign out.
- The designer has not been briefed but plans will shortly be finalized.

#### 4. MARY MAREFAT - STREET LIGHTING ON CONCANNON CIRCLE - NEW STREET LIGHT

The petitioner was not present. Members discussed the location history.

- A streetlight was requested at the end of the cul-de-sac.
- T. Ryder took night photos. There is a light at the intersection 200 feet from the cul-de-sac.
- He does not believe a light is necessary. He suggested increasing light intensity at Rosemary.
- A well-lit building abuts the cul-de-sac.
- Petitioner said Town plows back into the guardrail in the cul-de-sac.
  - o The reason for this is not for lack of lighting but due to the tight turnaround for plows there.
  - One suggestion is to add reflectors to the guardrail.
- The cost to add a light at the cul-de-sac is \$8,500-\$9,000 with license and permit fees to Eversource.
- The Town's Streetlight Maintenance program will be short \$6,500 this year.

#### 5. COMMITTEE DISCUSSION - TSC BUDGET AND POTENTIAL EXPENSE ITEMS

Members reviewed several years of TSC Budget accounting reports for comparison.

- The Fiscal year 2024 budget beginning 7/1/2023 is \$50,000 of which \$44,000 remains.
- The Fiscal year 2025 budget beginning 7/1/2024 will be an additional \$50,000.
- Funds do roll over from year to year but should be utilized.

Members discussed proposed items to consider purchasing with the \$44,000 balance:

- Ramp crossing at Webster St. \$12,000 share
- Pair of portable radar signs \$13,000
- Pilot stanchions for Warren St. \$ ???
- Solar RRFB at Dedham Ave. \$18,000
- Jersey barriers \$400 each

# DEDHAM AVE. PROJECT AT GEORGE AGGOTT RD. - POTENTIAL CROSSWALK

- The wired RRFB quote of \$22,000 with trenchwork for the conduit.
- A solar RFB would cost approximately \$18,000.
- Establish a crossing with signage.
- Decide whether the RRFB would be solar or wired.
- Physical improvements to consider: (speed analysis, counters, tubes, radar engineer)
- Split the cost of curbing
