CENTRAL AVENUE NEAR NORTH HILL'S DRIVEWAY

Marion Hersey, 881 Central Avenue, requested a slow or speed limit sign 25mph be put in the direction heading toward Newton at Central/North Hill. The speed limit is now posted at 35mph in that location. The members suggested that a letter similar to the 7/29/08 letter to Sally Toran, 945 Central Avenue be the response to Marion Hersey.
