*The Board granted a Special Permit on October 16, 1997 to Norfolk Lodge A.F. & A.M. allowing the selling of Christmas trees and related items during the holiday season based upon the submittal of a yearly letter of request with a letter from the Christ Episcopal Church allowing the selling on their premises. The requested sale period is from November 21 - December 24, 2021, Monday through Friday, 3:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m.; Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and Sunday Noon to 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Tamkin moved to grant the Norfolk Lodge A.F. & A.M. permission to sell Christmas trees and related items at 1111 Highland Avenue as allowed by the 1997 Special Permit limited to the hours and period specified in the submitted letters. Mr. Goldman seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.
