QUESTION:

I understand that Walker Pond is co-owned by the Town and the abutters, and that excessive aquatic vegetative overgrowth is now “limiting the recreational use of Walker Pond.” What is the nature (passive/active?) and location of current public access to the pond for recreational use?

ANSWER:

The primary recreational uses of the pond have been fishing, skating, bird watching, and quiet contemplation. There is an access path near the Walker Gordon playground.
