Essential Job Functions

- Reviews land and topographic survey and engineering projects as assigned by the Town Engineer to determine personnel, equipment and materials required.
- Perform diversified engineering duties to include surveying, research, design of sewer and water lines, roads, parking lots, traffic lights, grade crossings.
- Inspects construction work performed by Town personnel and outside contractors to ensure compliance with applicable Town, state, and federal standards and regulations.
- Participates in engineering compliance activities related to local, state, and federal legislation, regulations, and bylaws, such as ADA, wetlands, etc.
- Prepares and submits project records, reports, plans and other documents as required for Town files
- Collaborates with other Town Departments in monitoring and surveying of Town-owned lands to include the disposal area, athletic fields, parklands.
- Assist in the preparation of water consumption reports, sewer utilization data, and other statistical information required by the Town, state, and federal agencies.

Other Job Functions

- Performs related duties as assigned.
- Follow safe work practices.

- Three (3) to five (5) years of related experience in surveying techniques and basic engineering skills.
- Thorough knowledge of land surveying and basic civil engineering equivalent to completion of two years of college.
