2.	By deleting the definition of "Single-use plastic water bottle" from Section 3.13.1 in its entirety and re-lettering the remaining definition in Section 3.13.1 to account for said deletion.		
3.	By deleting Section 3.13.2.5 Single-Use Plastic Water Bottles in its entirety.		
4.	By amending Section 3.13.3 Effective Date to read as follows:		
	3.13.3 Effective D	ate.	
	This by-law shall take effect on January 1, 2025.		

5. By amending the second column of the row to be added to Section 8.2.2 (Non-Criminal Disposition) to read as follows: "Polystyrene Packaging Material, Single-Use Plastic Straws, Single-Use Plastic Stirrers and Plastic Splash Guards".

# ARTICLE 45: CITIZENS' PETITION – SINGLE USE PLASTICS BAN BY-LAW

MOVED: That the main motion under Article 45 be amended as follows:

1. By deleting from the definition of "Polystyrene" in Section 3.13.1.e) the following "; or ii) Clear or solid polystyrene, which is known as 'oriented polystyrene.", so that said definition reads as follows:

"Polystyrene" means any food, beverage, or other packaging materials made from a styrene monomer, including but not limited to:

- i) Expanded polystyrene (EPS), which is a thermoplastic petrochemical material utilizing a styrene monomer and processed by any number of techniques including, but not limited to, fusion of polymer spheres (expandable bead polystyrene), injection molding, form molding, and extrusion-blow molding (extruded foam polystyrene).
- 2. By amending the third column of the row to be added to Section 8.2.2 (Non-Criminal Disposition) to read as follows: "\$100".
