CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Paving Washburn Ave, Marshall St, and Gage St

This project includes paving a 1.5" overlay on the street surface. This work follows the installation of disability access ramps compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Paving work will begin the week of October 6th (weather permitting). Construction will primarily take place Monday-Friday from 7:00AM to 4:00PM. Highway personnel will start preparing the street ahead of paving operations.

The Department of Public Works will perform the milling and paving work with hired contractor D&R General Contracting according to MassDOT standards and Town specifications. The process will consist of:

- 1. Preparing the street by edging back the loam berm and repairing potholes
- 2. Raising metal castings (manhole covers, catch basins, etc.) to the new grade
- 3. Placing a 1.5" "top coat" of pavement with low profile asphalt curbing to help control berm erosion
- 4. Adjusting driveway aprons affected by the paving
- 5. Loaming and seeding of any disturbed areas

Residents are asked to please identify irrigation within two feet of the roadway, remove any objects placed on the sidewalk or berm, and trim back any overgrowth that may interfere with construction. During active construction we ask residents **not to park in the roadway** and refrain from any activity which could result in water collecting on its surface.

Please take into consideration that paving operations may cause delays in accessing your street\driveway. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions and allow access when safe.

The loaming/seeding process will take an additional 2-3 weeks after the paving has been completed. Helping us to water the newly seeded areas twice a day using a handheld hose, early morning and evening, will ensure optimal results. During this period please do not park on the new asphalt curbs or loam berms, as they can be easily damaged.
